This survey was conducted on **26<sup>th</sup> March, 2012** by the Social Conditions Programme of the Jesuit Centre for Theological Reflection. Average prices were calculated on the basis of prices gathered from retail outlets at Northmead, Shoprite (Cairo Road), and City Market, Chawama, Chainta, Kabwata, Matero and schools, clinics/hospitals around Lusaka. The March Basic Needs Basket is approximately **US\$559** based upon an average middle exchange rate of 5250 Kwacha per US\$ at the end of March.
