This survey was conducted on **27 & 28 October 2010** by the Social Conditions Programme of the Jesuit Centre for Theological Reflection. Average prices were calculated on the basis of prices gathered from retail outlets at Northmead, Shoprite (Kafue Road), and City Market, Chawama, Chainta, Kabwata, Matero and schools, clinics/hospitals around Lusaka. The October Basic Needs Basket is approximately **US\$589 based** upon an average middle exchange rate of 4890 Kwacha per US\$ at the end of October.
